
As part of this development, we are also actively advancing our digitalisation projects to further increase efficiency. enhance transparency to meet the growing requirements for compliance and traceability.

With an annual production capacity of 120 tonnes of gold and 140 tonnes of silver, the facility makes a significant contribution to the local economy.

Our approach is guided by the OECD Due Diligence Guidance as well as internationally recognised industry standards, such as the Responsible Jewellery Council (RJC) Code of Practices and Chain of Custody Standard, the London Bullion Market Association (LBMA) Responsible Gold Guidance, the London Platinum and Palladium Market (LPPM) Responsible Platinum and Palladium Guidance and the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP) of the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI).

CODE OF CONDUCT

We are committed to ethical, lawful and responsible behaviour. Integrity, transparency, respect, sustainability and strict compliance with laws and internal regulations are at the core of our actions. We take pride in upholding these values.

SUSTAINABILITY AND RESPONSIBLE BUSINESS PRACTICES

This policy defines binding standards for sustainability, human rights and responsible conduct throughout the entire supply chain and applies to all employees and business partners.





ANTI-MONEY LAUNDERING (AML) AND KNOW YOUR COUNTERPARTY (KYC)

We have implemented comprehensive anti-money-laundering and KYC procedures to verify the identity of customers and business partners, detect unusual or suspicious transactions, and comply with national and international requirements. Regular reviews and training ensure the effectiveness of our programme.

We pursue a zero-tolerance policy towards corruption and bribery. All employees and representatives are obliged to avoid improper advantages or conflicts of interest. Violations are consistently investigated and sanctioned.

TRANSPARENCY IN THE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

REPORTING OBLIGATIONS AND DISCLOSURE

Transparency is a guiding principle of our management system. We ensure that relevant information on business processes, compliance and supply chains is systematically recorded, disclosed and documented in a traceable manner. This includes statutory reporting obligations as well as voluntary disclosures to stakeholders.

MONITORING, AUDITS AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Regular internal and external audits review compliance with our standards and identify opportunities for improvement. The insights gained feed into the enhancement of our processes and are monitored through our continuous improvement process to ensure ongoing effectiveness.

RESPONSIBLE SOURCING

RESPONSIBLE SOURCING OF PRECIOUS METALS FROM CONFLICT-FREE SOURCES

philoro MELTING & REFINING GmbH is committed to the responsible sourcing of precious metals from conflict-free sources. In line with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance and the requirements of the RJC standards, we have established a comprehensive supply chain policy as part of our Public Policy and ensure its implementation through our integrated management system.

DUE DILIGENCE IN THE SUPPLY CHAIN

Our organisational structure ensures effective risk management within the supply chain and compliance with all relevant legal and industry-specific standards. Responsibilities are clearly defined. The Compliance Officer is responsible for implementing the KYC process, conducting risk assessments and providing regular reports to management.

The due diligence process includes the systematic review of new and existing business partners. This comprises the initiation of the KYC process, the execution of due diligence, the decision on entering a business relationship and ongoing monitoring.

Business partners are informed about our Public Policy during the KYC onboarding process and - by signing it - commit to adhering to its principles. This ensures transparency, compliance and responsible conduct throughout the entire supply chain.

RISK MANAGEMENT

The precious-metals supply chain involves both risks and opportunities. Operating responsibly requires a solid system for the continuous identification, assessment and management of risks. Careful review and risk identification are therefore an essential part of our corporate culture.

Our risk management approach considers process-related, strategic, legal, social and environmental aspects. Particular focus is placed on risks related to business conduct, community and reputation, human rights, occupational health and safety, legal compliance, supply chain integrity and sustainability.



RISK-BASED CATEGORISATION OF SUPPLIERS

As part of our due diligence system, we assess all business partners based on clearly defined risk criteria. This assessment takes into account, among other factors, the geographical origin, ownership structure, nature of the business activity and additional indicators that may point to potential risks related to human rights, the environment, ethics or the financing of conflict. Based on this analysis, a risk-based classification is carried out to ensure an appropriate level of review and ongoing monitoring.

Business partners identified as a higher risk are subject to enhanced due diligence and strengthened monitoring. Where necessary, additional verification measures are implemented to confirm or clarify potential risks.

Our due diligence system is regularly reviewed and adapted to new regulatory and industry developments to ensure the effectiveness of our measures to prevent and mitigate risks.



ONGOING MONITORING

The supply chain is continuously monitored and regularly reassessed. During the reporting period, no red flags or irregularities were identified in relation to human rights, environmental impacts, working conditions, business ethics or the origin of materials.

CONFLICT-AFFECTED AND HIGH-RISK AREAS (CAHRAS)

As part of our due diligence process, we also consider potential risks associated with Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (CAHRAs). The classification is based on the CAHRAs overview published by the European Union at www.cahraslist.net.

philoro MELTING & REFINING does not source any materials from origins associated with conflict, human-rights violations or unethical practices.

TRANSPARENT SUPPLY CHAIN

For every transaction, comprehensive records are maintained documenting all relevant information regarding the origin, type, quantity and assay results of the materials as well as the suppliers involved and the transportation routes used. This ensures full transparency and traceability throughout the supply chain.

OUR CUSTOMERS AND PARTNERS

We consistently place our customers at the centre of our activities and safeguard their interests as well as their personal data. With experience and dedication, we strive to meet their needs and foster long-term, partnership-based relationships built on trust and responsible business practices.

To this end, we work in close collaboration with refineries, recycling facilities, precious-metals dealers, pawnshops, jewellers, goldsmiths, jewellery retailers and wedding-ring manufacturers.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY


At philoro, the responsible use of valuable resources is a central priority. To fulfill this commitment, we have implemented an environmental management system in accordance with ISO 14001:2015 and have committed ourselves to the continuous improvement of our environmental performance, compliance with all legal obligations and resource-efficient production.

This includes responsible handling of all waste and emissions to air, water and soil, the implementation of measures to increase energy and water efficiency and ensuring the sustainable and efficient use of natural resources.

Based on our corporate policy, we conducted a context analysis followed by a risk assessment and subsequently developed an environmental programme. During the reporting year, we implemented a sustainability dashboard and its results will be reflected in the expanded ESG reporting next year.

REFINERY "GOLDWERK" KORNEUBURG - SUSTAINABLE CONSTRUCTION

The philoro refinery "GOLDWERK" Korneuburg, opened in December 2023, sets new standards in sustainability and resource efficiency. We use advanced technologies to minimise energy consumption and environmental impact. Heating and cooling are provided exclusively through renewable energy sources, supported by a photovoltaic system for on-site electricity generation. Water, lighting and shading systems are managed through smart controls. The site also features electric-mobility infrastructure that supports sustainable transportation solutions.







SUSTAINABLE. VALUABLE.

FOCUS ON RECYCLING

The recovery of secondary gold is one of our core competencies, returning valuable metals to the economic cycle in a sustainable manner. The entire process is designed to conserve resources and minimise the ecological footprint.

ENERGY

A central aspect of sustainability at the refinery is the use of solar energy, generated through a large-scale photovoltaic system. This measure significantly reduces CO₂ emissions and supports a sustainable energy supply.

To minimise environmental impacts and comply with all

legal requirements, we rely on modern exhaust-air

Another key element of our sustainability strategy is the implementation of a closed water cycle. This system enables the treatment and repeated use of the water


